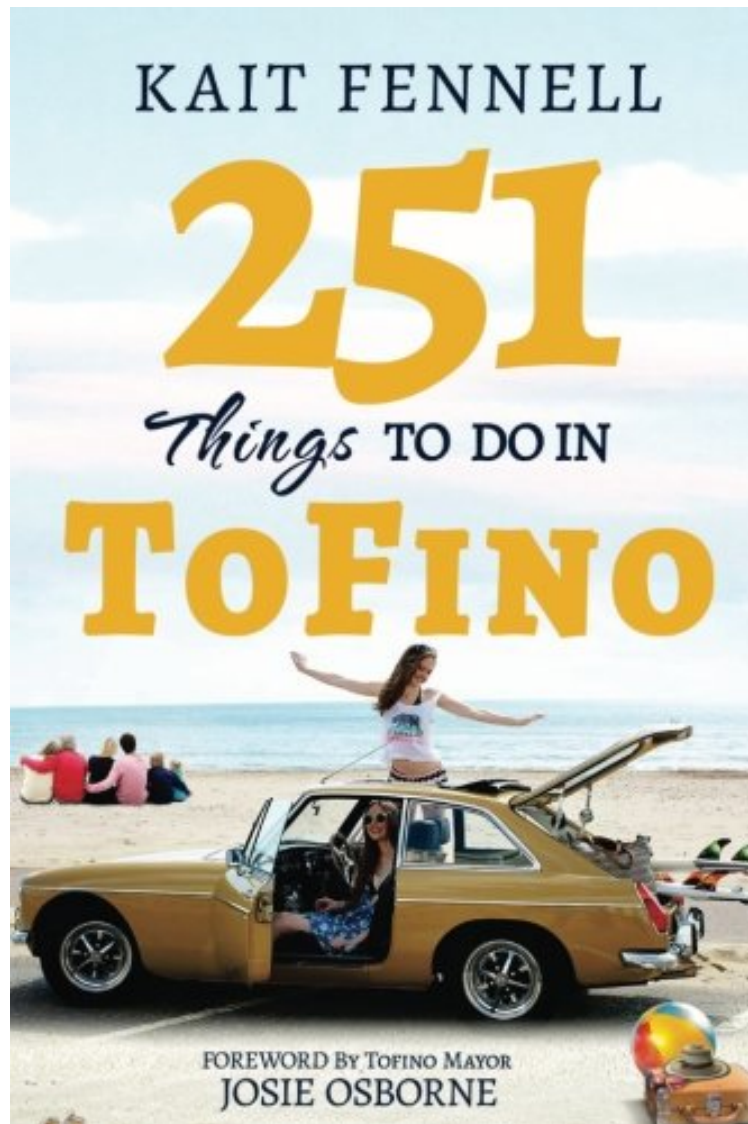

Chambers A few months before I retired in November 2001, I attended a retirement seminar where one of the speakers recommended that retirees go on a trip immediately after retiring. Partly because of this, my wife and I looked around for air fare deals and chose Vancouver, BC for a post-retirement vacation. A couple of days after I walked out of the

office for the last time, we flew from Atlanta to Vancouver, BC, rented a car, drove to the car ferry, and found ourselves on Vancouver Island where we spent the night, then drove the next day to Tofino, where we spent three delightful days. It's a lovely, quaint little town, and we had a blast, taking a floatplane over glaciers and seeing a whale breaching in one of the bays, walking out on the sand at low tide and seeing hundreds of colorful starfish clinging to the rocks, and watching surfers come flying across the waves. Those fond memories came back to me while I was reading *251 Things to Do in Tofino*. The book showed me that we had only scratched the surface of fun activities in Tofino. The book is very thorough in covering Tofino, including the long, colorful history of the town. The 251 things to do included hiking trails, entertainment, food and drink, art and artists, shopping, rainy days and winter activities, camping, and kids activities. The book also includes an annual events calendar. My favorite part of the book was the "This is my Tofino" section, where local residents talk about Tofino and tell what they would do if they had only one day in the town. My only quibble - and it's a minor one - is that most distances are given only in kilometers with no English (Imperial) conversions. The book is a very detailed, helpful guide to getting the most out of a trip to Tofino.

The author starts with definitions and these give the reader an idea of the range of things to see and do in Tofino. She then gives us rules on how to act like a local that I found entertaining. So you can fit in, if that is your desire. There is a short section on local slang and what you need to bring with you. Kait gives you many useful tips on traveling to Tofino, what to bring, how to talk. I enjoyed reading the essays from the local people about when they came to Tofino, what drew them there, why they stayed in the community. This group not only stayed but they started businesses in the community and made it their permanent home. The descriptions of the ocean, the waves, the beaches, the mudflats, the rainforest, the coffee, the hiking, and the food made me want to pack my bag and book my ticket. I'm sold on the location. It sounds like a wonderful place to visit. I believe this work deserves five stars out of five. I read this book from cover to cover which is not something I usually do with travel guides.
