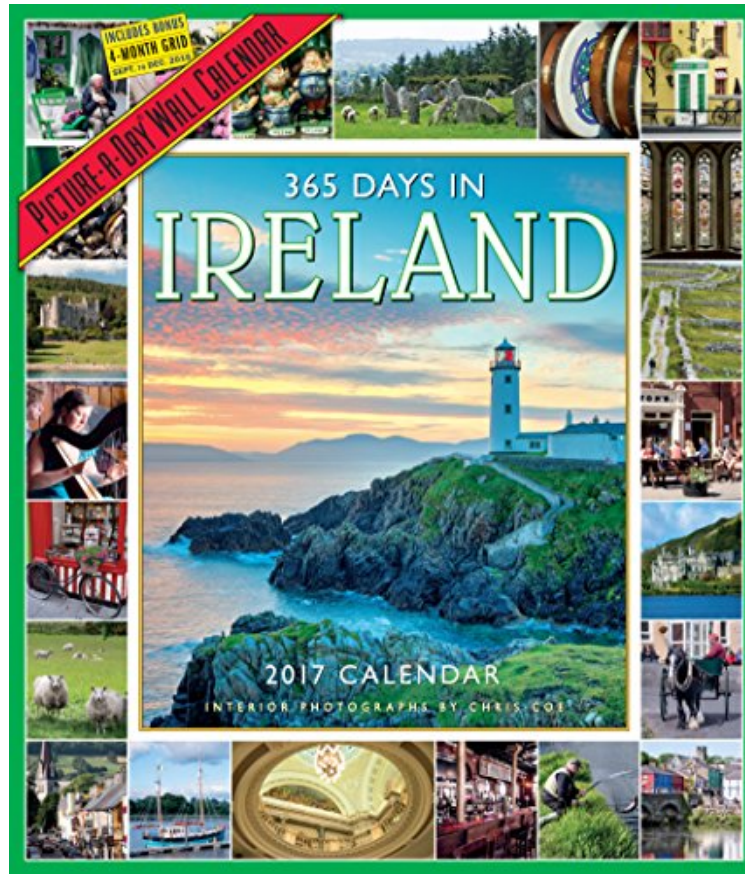

...By Mary S.They say full-color photos. So they ARE all in color, but a lot smaller than you think. The bulk of them  
(less than a photo a day) are far smaller - maybe 2" by 1.5". The month of January features a large picture of a field of  
sheep (9.5" x 8"). There are, in addition 8 January photos that measure 3"x1.5", and the rest are small ones about 1-1/2"  
by less than 1-1/2". Hardly "full-sizeJust so you know, Thurs. Jan 19 is a small photo of cows. Dates Sun. Jan  
22/Monday 23 and Jan 29/Jan30 are in the left hand bottom corner. One photo covers all 4 dates -- more sheep - this  
time posing under a tree. It would have been far better for me to buy a calendar with one large photo per month since  
this was intended as a small gift. I don't want to see a picture of bacon, sausage and tomatoes such as for Feb. 7 and  
8th. Dates Sept. 7, 8 and 9 are more sheep - this time crossing a road with a mtn. backdrop. So, buyer beware -- 365  
days of "Ireland" photographs also covers sheep, cows and eggs. I would not have bought this type calendar had I

realized these things in advance. The very best photo is on the cover of the calendar - Fanad Head Lighthouse, Donegal, Ireland.
