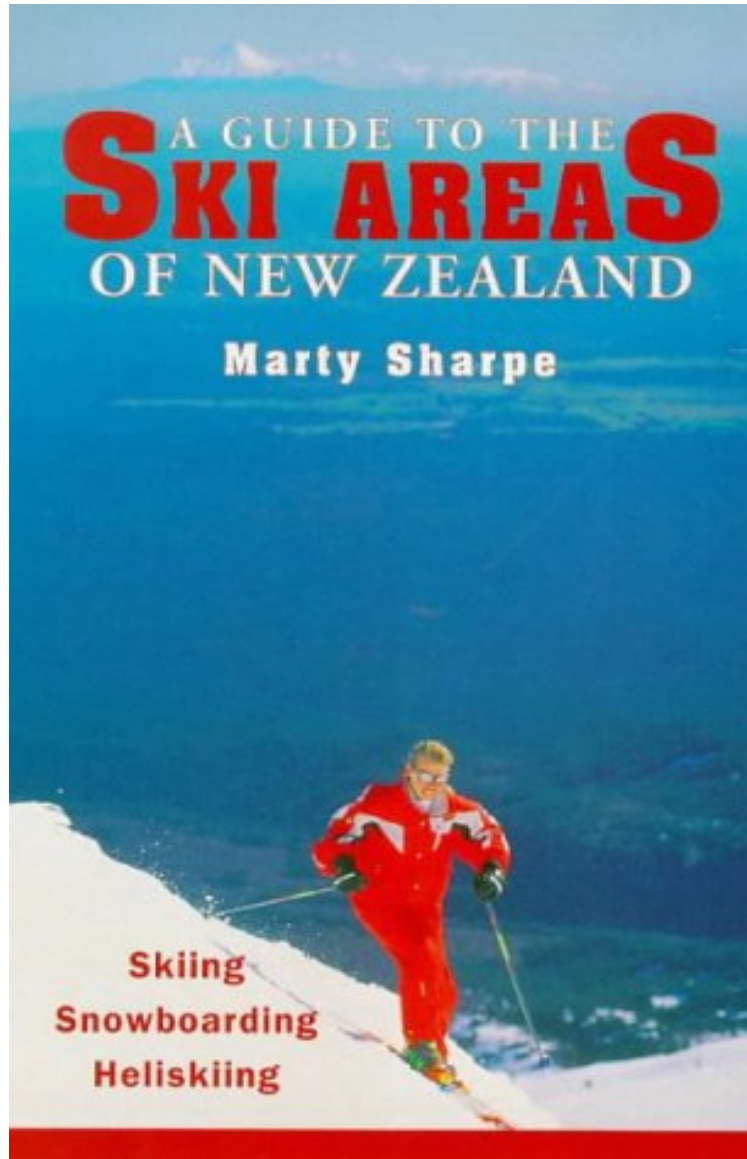

The club ski areas are unique I think and may appeal to the intrepid skier. Some effort is required to even reach these locations so it is uncharted territory in many ways. Information is also provided about

transportation options, ski hire availability, meals and accomodation. Reference is made to major ski towns like Queenstown and Methven. I don't know why "National Park" hasn't got a name but this and other curiosities will surely make for an interesting journey. For each ski area there is a description of beginner, intermediate and advanced skiing. A slightly smaller typeface and a star system of ratings might have saved a few trees but all in all it is a good effort.

This guide to New Zealand's ski areas covers each area - with a full description, of its facilities, and slopes, a trail map and price guide. It also includes information on where to stay, dine, where to party or where to enjoy a quiet drink.
