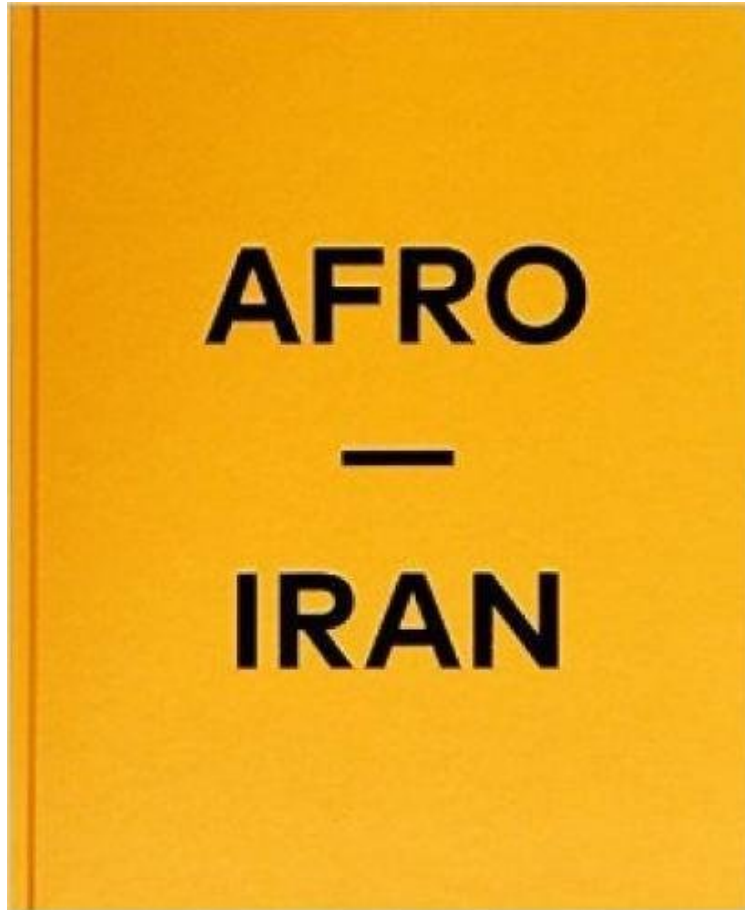

And while there was five pages of text discussing Afro-Iranian, the font was so huge, it would have amounted to only one page in another book. This could have been such an interesting, rich and informative book, unfortunately it was more of a high school report. Very disappointing.

Ehsaei shows a side of Iran, which is widely unknown even to Iranians: a minority of people who influenced the culture of a whole region by continuing their African heritage with their clothing style, their music, their dance and
