Hedges "Professor Pathfinder's Air Travelers' Map Guide" is a laminated six-panel accordion-fold map on heavy cardstock that is a quite useful reference for air travelers, although I wish it had been slightly smaller to better fit in the outer pockets of carry-on luggage. The largest image is a map of the United States with most commercial airports depicted along with their names and their three-letter identifiers. It is useful to find potential alternative routings, as well as a general geographical reference. Inset panels serve various purposes, such as a more detailed depiction of the congested Northeast US corridor, Alaska, Hawaii, and very general Europe and world maps for very general orientation. One of its best features is the information on the airports depicted on the reverse side, with location information, contact information, website information, distance and taxi fares to city centers, etc. There is also Internet and phone contact information for many airlines big and small, from giants like Delta to very small operators like New Mexico Airlines. There is even a section of US contact phone numbers for selected foreign carriers, most of which are quite large. As with any map like this, information (particularly airline and airport contact information) is subject to change, and despite the relatively recent revision date of 2007, there are airlines listed here that have gone out of business (e.g. Aloha Airlines, Skybus, etc.) while others have merged and are no longer doing business under the listed name (e.g. Northwest Airlines, which merged with Delta.) These are generally trivial matters, but do warrant an update from Hedburg Maps. I think this is a useful map for frequent air travelers and despite the occasionally out of date data and format that's just a tad too big to stow easily in a suit coat pocket (or in outer pockets of some carry on luggage.)
