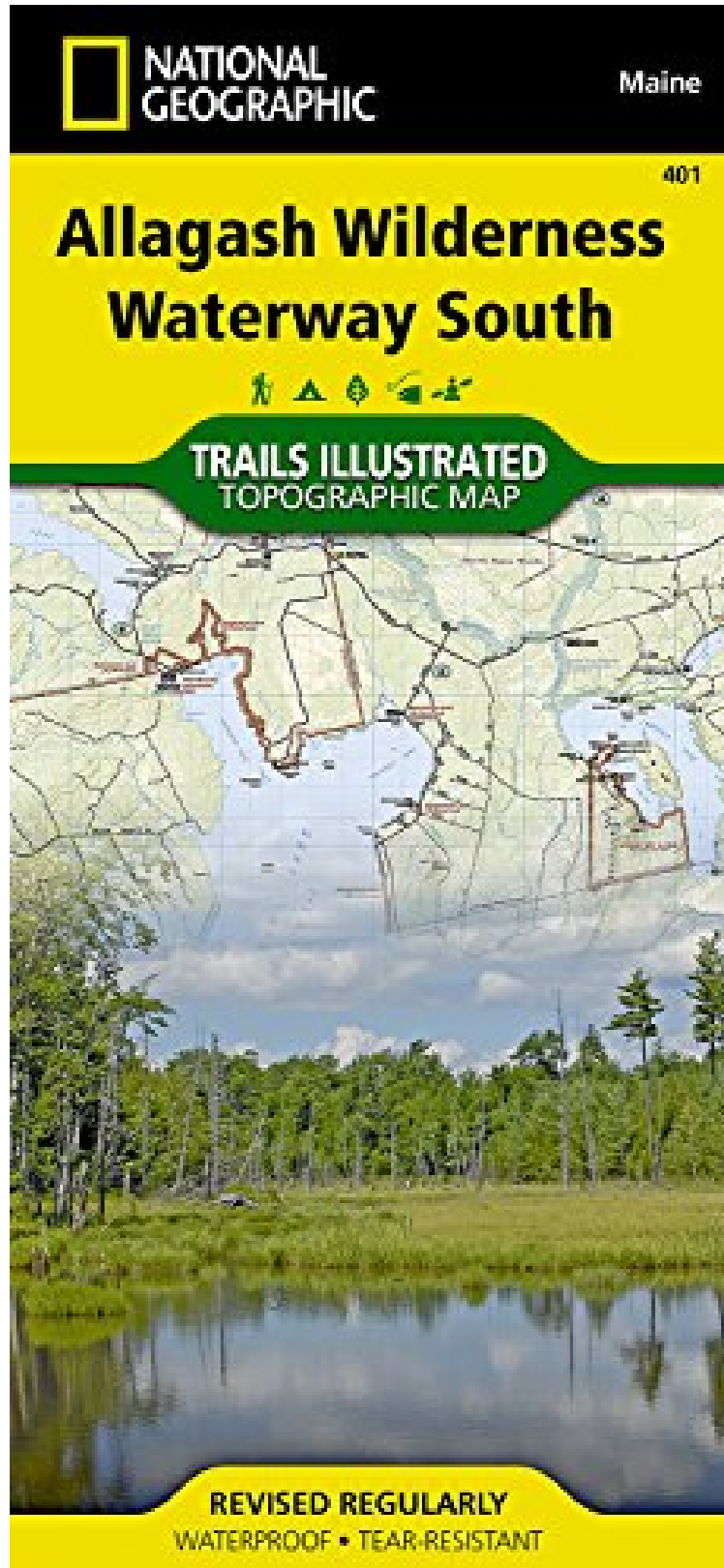

They are very detailed with 1 inch equaling 1 mile or a scale of 1:63,360. The legend covers all the various stake holders which makeup the quilt of public and private lands, in a simple color coated fashion. The map includes the waterway regs, which is handy as a part of pretrip planning. If you fish the map details include many side brooks, ponds and lakes you may wish to try. It comes on a coated paper which should be water repellent.I have 2 issues with the set. First there is a compromise between scale and have this waterway on a single map.
