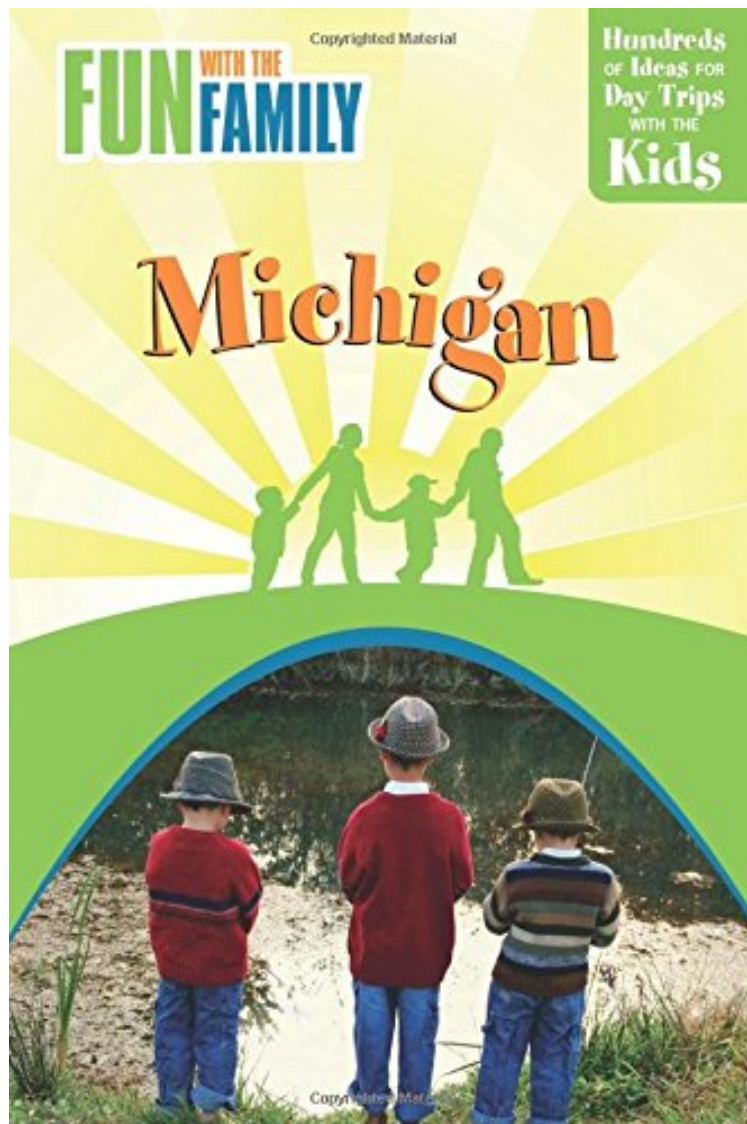


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Fun with the Family Michigan, 7th: Hundreds of Ideas for Day Trips with the Kids (Fun with the Family Series)
