The Galpago Islands (official name: Archipelago de Coln ; other Spanish names: Islas de Coln or Islas Galpagos) are an archipelago of volcanic islands distributed around the Ecuador in the Pacific Ocean, 972 km (525 nmi) west of continental Ecuador, of which they are a part. The Galpagos Islands and its surrounding waters form an Ecuadorian province, a national park, and a biological marine reserve. The principal language on the islands is Spanish. The islands have a population of slightly over 25,000. The islands are geologically young and famed for their vast number of endemic species, which were studied by Charles Darwin during the voyage of the Beagle. His observations and collections contributed to the inception of Darwin's theory of evolution by natural selection. More recently, the Ecuadorian government gave most of the islands Spanish names. While the Spanish names are official, many users

(especially ecological researchers) continue to use the older English names, principally because those were the names used when Charles Darwin visited.
