This travel journal does exactly what it should do - it provides simple prompts that children of all ages will be able to thoughtfully complete. There's room for drawings and/or pictures. The prompts are based on sensory experiences, gratitude, and balance (most favorite thing/least favorite thing). Because anyone who travels with children knows that sometimes the least favorite part of the day can end up being one of the most memorable experiences of the trip! I like the size of the book - it's easy to slip into a backpack, which our kids often use as their only bag on a trip. I wish we had started something like this when our kids were younger - it would be fun to have the first section of the book be filled in by the parents before the kids can write, and then later to see the child's handwriting change as they start to write their own answers and fill in pages over the years. Highly recommend this simple, functional travel journal.
