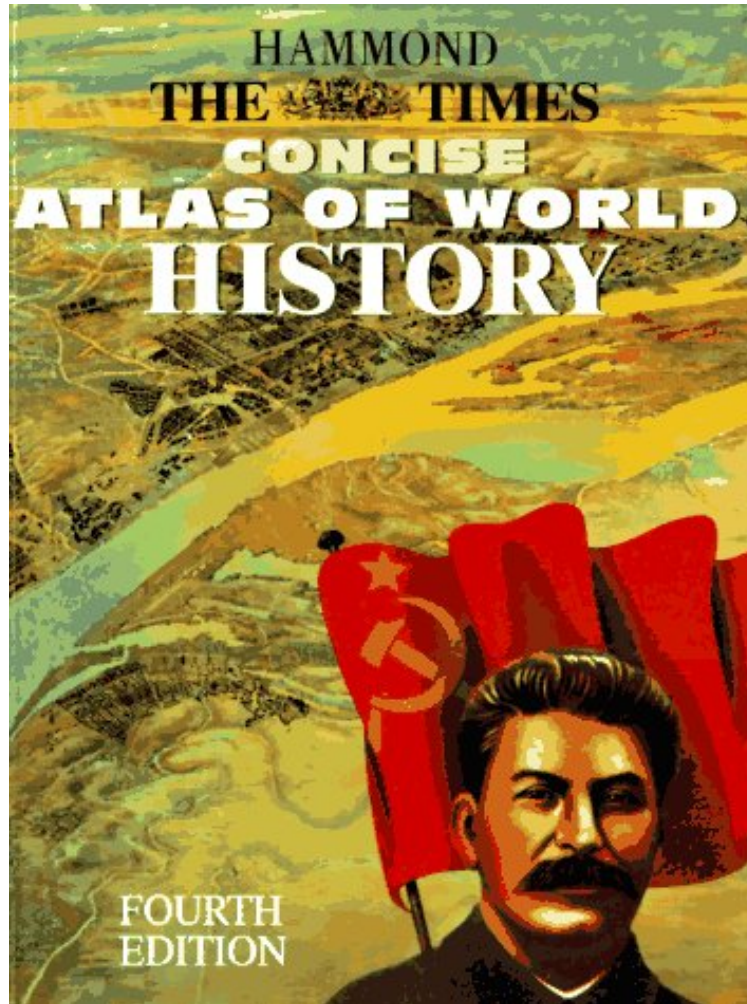

The text provides a synopsis of the era and is just the right length and detail level.
