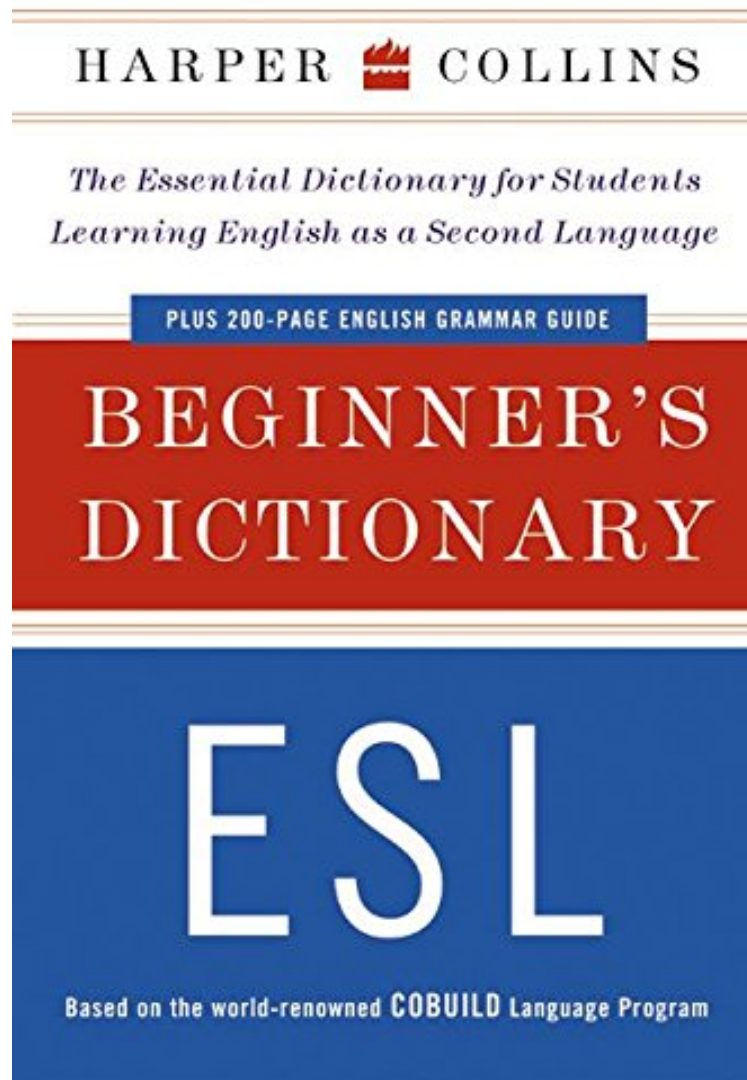

For example, the long I sound in "dive" is "AI", but in older pronunciation keys the symbol "I" with a horizontal line above it is used. Most people of my generation are familiar with the older method of showing vowel sounds. As an English as Second

Language tutor, I would have to re-do all my pronunciation materials if my student(s) used this dictionary. For this and other reasons, it would not be my choice. The American Heritage Children's Dictionary is a better book. It is a larger format book, is illustrated throughout, pronunciation is given in the more familiar format and the typography is easier on the eyes.
