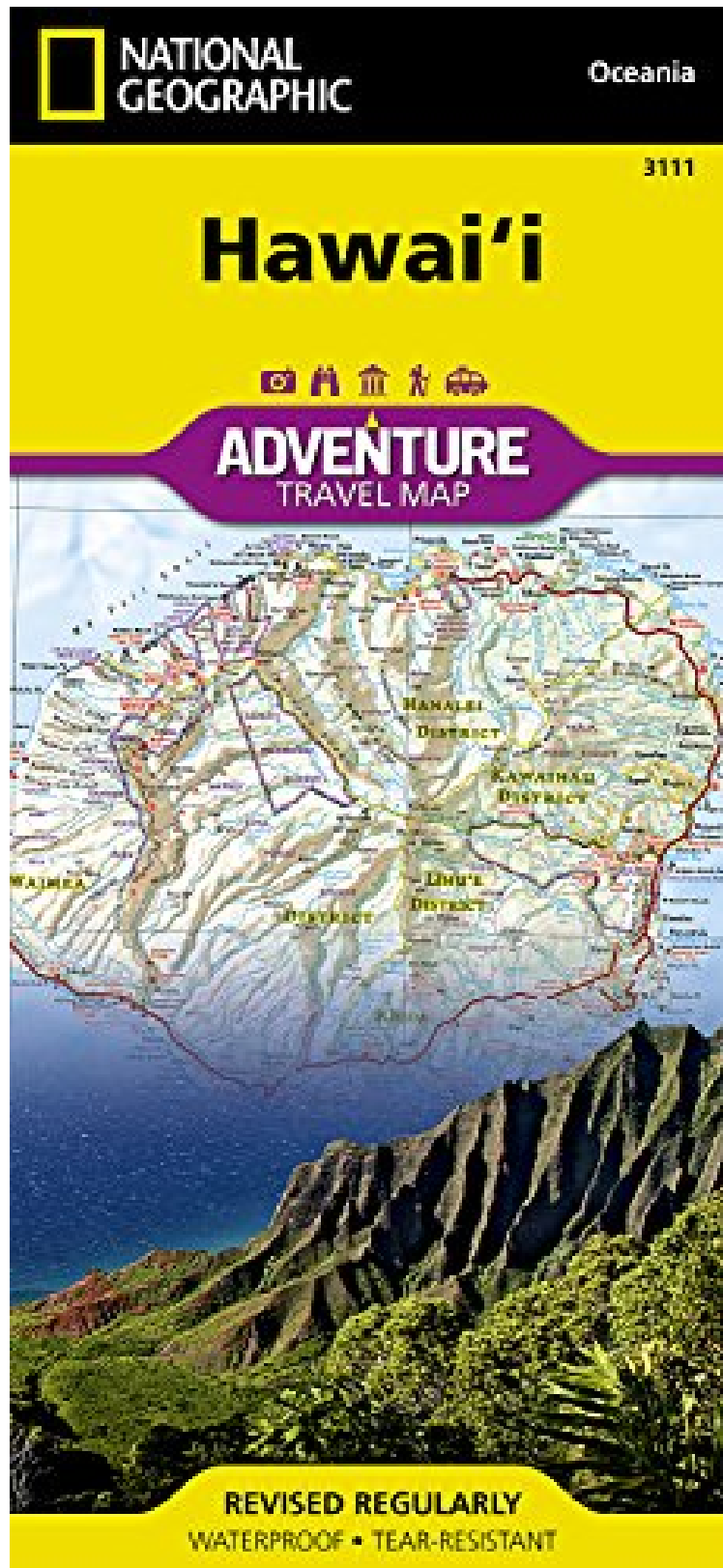

The road was completed after the map was printed and a new version is not available.NOTE: This new highway is missing from most Hawaii (Big Island) maps and is something to know because it makes the trip cross island much, much nicer.
