This book's tone and approach is upbeat, energized, chomping-at-the-bit evangelism - a pep rally for folks who may not have considered just how many viable years of Christian service opportunity still lay ahead in their own lives. As such, its a fine book with fine content. I'd perhaps remind readers to be very sensitive toward the elderly. Some, whose life boots show quite heavy wear are not meant to climb back into uniform and ambitiously wield the Sword. With aging comes a regimen of transitions that may or may not be so easy to field - the potency of gravity, aging, family dynamics, economy, health changes, choices made, etc. Receiving a comforting, healing word is not outside God's clipboard assignment to the aged. And God accords permission and license to elderly humans to finally retire - whether shut-in, of delimited mobilities or faculties. Retiring from active duty by no means disqualifies a soldier, of any rank, of all their vested Veteran benefits. Same in Heaven as on Earth.
