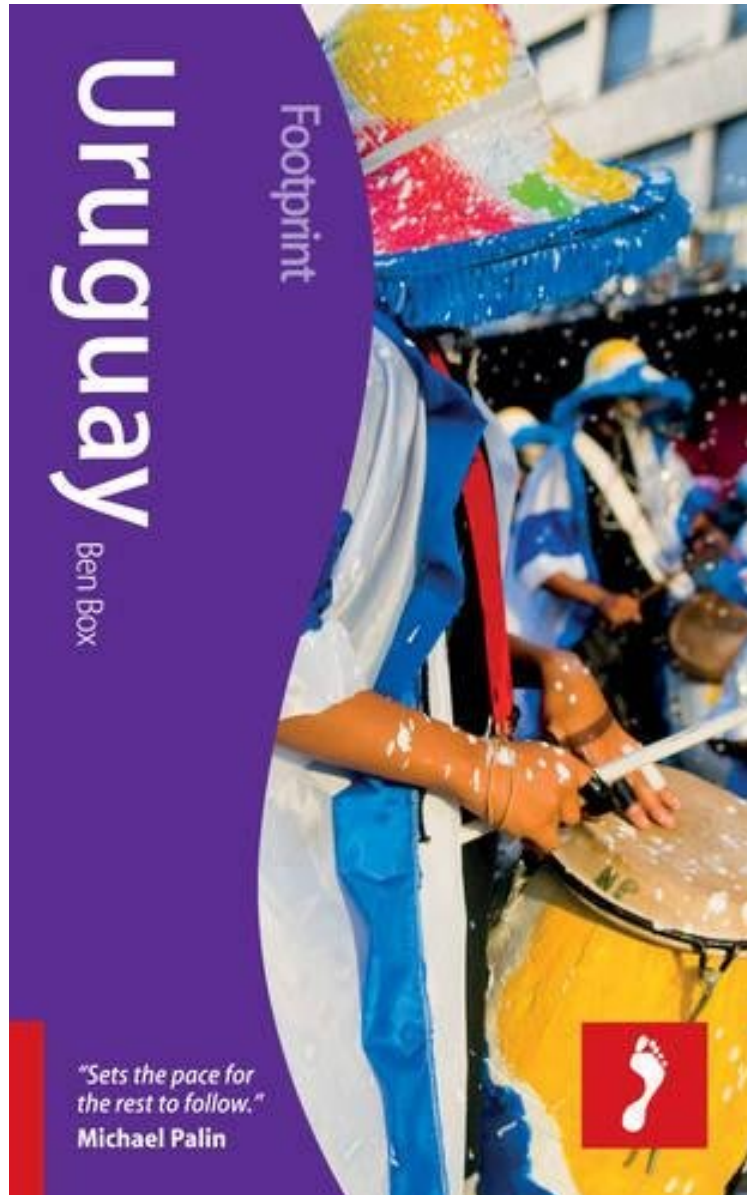

on South America. The only good thing about the Focus book is that it fits easily in your pocket, unlike Footprint's monster book. In retrospect, I suspect that it would have been more cost-effective to simply photocopy relevant pages from the big book from which the Focus book's content was drawn. Most of the content is so terse as to be useless. If I had relied solely on this garbage for planning my vacation I would have been in big, big trouble. (Fortunately I am a good researcher.) The basic problem is that Footprint needs to either scale up their big book to do justice to the continent it purportedly covers, or drastically expand the books in the Focus series and then condense their content for the big South America book. This book is more like an essay than a travel guide. It looks more like a chapter pulled from a larger guide book on South America. There are 57 pages on the country of Uruguay and 30 on the city of Buenos Aires. The picture on this page is colorful and misleading, the only quality in the construction on this book is the cover, granted it is small enough to fit in your pocket.
