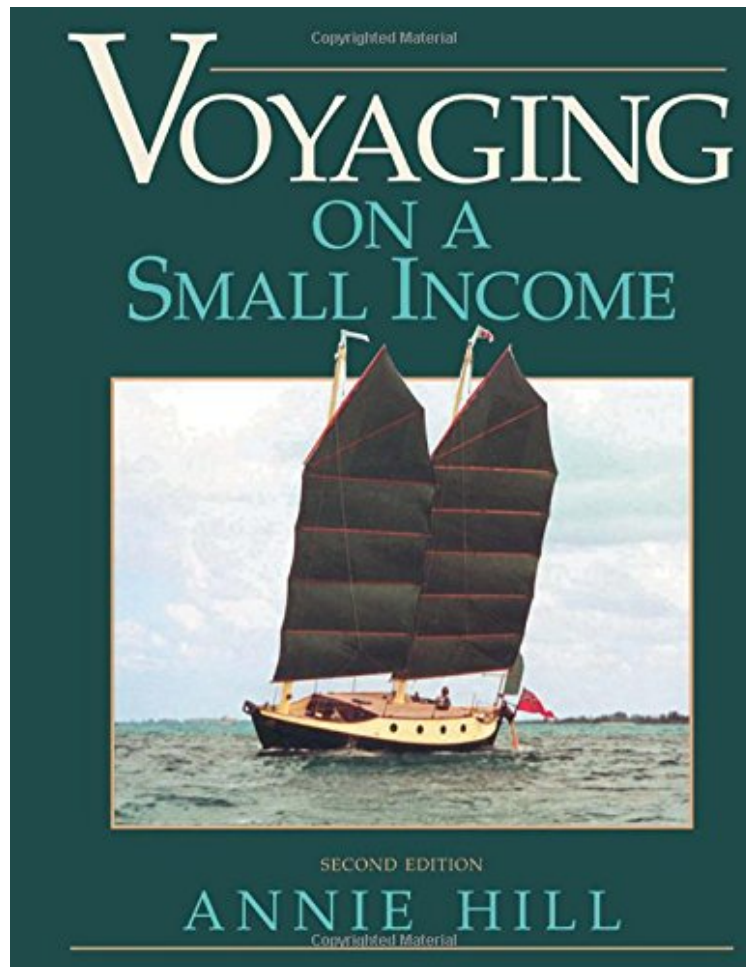

The lifestyle Annie Hill suggests is not for everyone, nor quite as inexpensive as it was to start in 1975, but well worth reading and considering. Voyaging on a Small Income has snippets of their cruising stories which help to keep the reader interested and to better illustrate Mrs Hill's points. My biggest gripe with this is the rather closed-minded view of other means of cruising that sometimes crop up in the writing, but as with most cruisers she has strong opinions and is willing to voice them. The second biggest issue is the publishing. Some chapter headers are missing the oversize capital letters that start each off and there is at least one table that is mis-formatted and hard to read. All in all, I recommend it for anyone interested in sailing and saving.

Maintaining that there is little preventing one from cruising the world by boat, this book provides practical ideas for turning one's dreams of life at sea into reality, with suggestions for preplanning and simplifying one's life.
