Peru and LimaBy Brian AllenThe map is quite adequate for traveling in Peru but as Peru is such a huge country some detail is missing. For example the small village we stayed in to view Condors east of Santa Eulalia is not on the map. The only inset map with detail is for Lima. I was surprised not to see maps for Cusco, Machu Picchu, or any of the other large cities of Peru. The Nelles Peru/Ecuador map had better insert maps of cities and places of interest.The map is labeled as waterproof. It still feels very light and not thick like some laminated maps but I have not subjected it to rain and can not vouch for it's waterproof claim. Elevations were shaded on my map and selected mountain peaks were labeled with their elevation in meters. The Nelles map has relief shading that doesn't show elevation as well but shows valleys and and canyons more easily. Most archeological sites and ruins were labeled as well as national and regional parks and reserves. All in all a good value.
