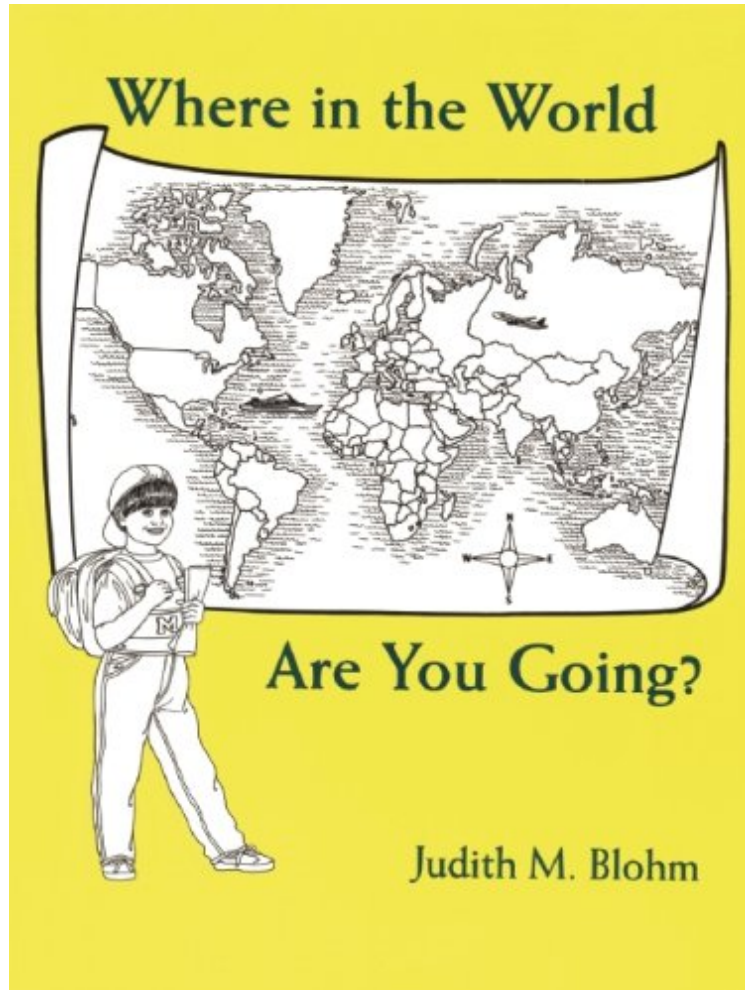

It's been well received by my kids who have enjoyed working through it. The process it follows feels right, and though there were no new concepts (we had talked about many of the issues it raises with our kids), it does present them in a clear and organised way that makes it worthwhile. Although I was given this

book, I've since recommended it to several people. My biggest advice is get more than one! You'll need one for each kid to avoid arguments, although we dealt with that by "sharing" pages. My only criticisms are that it does feel a little old fashioned, so doesn't really acknowledge much in the way of modern technology which would form a useful update to the book, particularly if you were using it with older children. For reference, my kids are currently 5 and 6.

*Where in the World Are You Going?* is an entertaining activity book that helps young children, ages five to ten, through the process of moving abroad. Children can go through the book and complete the activities alone or with a parent. Attractive and creative line drawings appear throughout the book. *Where in the World Are You Going?* is a helpful resource for parents.
