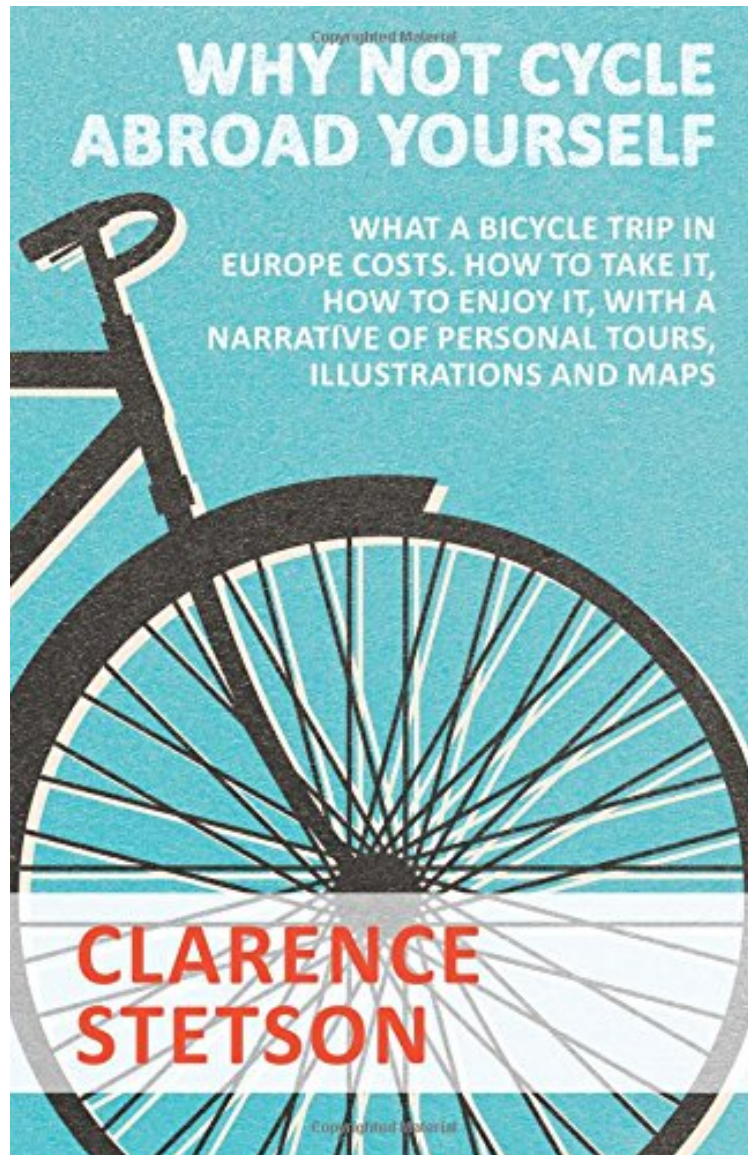

The copyright date is 2013, leaving one to believe that this is current information about cycling in Europe. However, the contents and maps are from the late 1800's, with the final chapter discussing the World Expo in Paris in 1900. When I came to the site to see how it was described, it is listed as a "vintage" book. But for anyone wanting to cycle in Europe today, much of the contents are so totally out of date as to be useless. The historical information on bicycling is interesting. My friend intended the gift to be useful to us in an upcoming trip. Unless you're a history buff and interested in "the way it was," much of the book is irrelevant. Rather deceptive advertising in my opinion.
