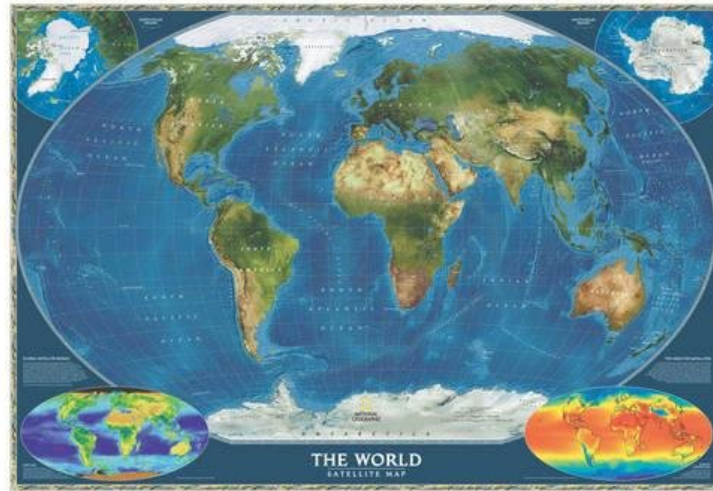

By cc This is a nice vividly colored map. I needed an inexpensive world map for my classroom to be able to make quick reference to "where things are" in relation to where we live. I also make many references to ocean currents and temperature zones. This map is useful in allowing students to visualize the concepts. I do wish it had ocean currents highlighted in a light blue over the oceans, but the temperature map makes up for that. It also labels the Mid Atlantic Ridge which is so helpful in getting students to envision this in relation to the size of the Earth. I do wish it were twice the size, but for the price, it is a great map. Note: this map was too large to fit in the laminator at our school, so be aware that you may have to hang it as is, without the laminate protection. I would recommend this map.

Inset maps detail the biosphere, surface temperature, and the polar regions. The beauty and complexity of Earth's landscapes, both above and below the oceans, is revealed with the Global Satellite Mosaic which was produced for National Geographic Society by NASA's Jet Propulsion Laboratory. The map is encapsulated in heavy-duty 1.6 mil laminate which makes the paper much more durable and resistant to the swelling and shrinking caused by changes in humidity. Laminated maps can be framed without the need for glass, so the frames can be much lighter and less expensive. Map Scale = 1:38,931,000 Sheet Size = 43.5" x 30.5"
